## International Congress for Joint Reconstruction Announces Launch of New Online Medical Journal

### ***Publication Results from New Alliance with Joint Implant Surgery and Research Foundation***

(San Diego) – The [International Congress for Joint Reconstruction](#) (ICJR) has announced the launch of *Reconstructive Review*, a new online medical journal launched on October 31, 2011, in collaboration with the Joint Implant Surgery and Research Foundation (JISRF).

Available quarterly, the new journal will focus on timely issues connected with “real-life orthopaedics, with participation from a broad range of orthopedic professionals. The journal has a peer review process, with more than 50 members from around the world on its editorial board. Beginning in 2012, *Reconstructive Review* will publish abstracts from selective ICJR meetings.
